

## Minutes – Collaborative Meeting, Friday, March 8, 2024

Tom Niswander, FCFC Board Treasurer, called the meeting to order at 12:01pm a.m. Introductions were made by those present. Attendees were asked to look over the minutes from February 9, 2024, for approval. After a motion to approve the minutes and seconded the minutes were approved without correction.

The speaker for today's meeting was Flor Mendoza, Regional Lead Coordinator, N.GA Health District. Flor presented on the Childhood Lead Poisoning Prevention program from the State Department of Public Health. Lead poisoning is still a concern in our communities. We are all exposed to lead through everyday items, hobbies, and occupations. Lead poisoning in children can lead to developmental delays, behavioral changes, and lower IQ among other damages. Testing children under the age of 6 is crucial to detect lead poisoning and initiate a home visit to identify sources of lead exposure. Inspections are free to homes with children. All children that are on Medicaid are automatically tested for lead poisoning at 12 and 24 months of age at their doctor's office.

Sherry Morris mentioned a Book Study on "What Happened to You?" Conversations On Trauma, Resilience, and Healing by Bruce Perry, MD, PhD, and Oprah Winfrey. Join Jordan VanHorn and Sherry Morris as FCFC hosts this book study group on Tuesday afternoons March 26<sup>th</sup>, April 9<sup>th</sup>, and April 23<sup>rd</sup>. Sessions will be held from 3:30pm – 5:30 pm in person and available for virtual attendance. FCFC has 18 books that can be loaned for the book Study.
