Metro Area Children's Water Festival
Minnesota State Fair Grounds

The Metro Conservation Districts have held this annual event in September at the Minnesota State Fairgrounds in St. Paul, Minnesota, USA. It is designed to provide students with hands-on opportunities to learn about water and its importance to people and our natural environment. At past festivals, students learned about things such as how scientists measure the quality of water, where the water goes when the toilet gets flushed, how tiny bugs can serve as indicators of water quality, the importance of wetlands, and basic water science. In past years, about 1,200 – 1,300 fourth grade students have attended the festival from the seven Metropolitan counties to celebrate our most precious resource: water.

Tips Outdoors youth will learn about the positive benefits that spending time together fishing and being outdoors with their family and friends will have in their lives and the lives of their family and friends...and how important conservation of our lakes, rivers and natural water resources are for their lives and for future generations.
