

REDUCE HARMS FOR PEOPLE WHO USE DRUGS



- O1. Identifying points of access for naloxone in underserved and marginalized communities and creating a mechanism for education and distribution.
- **O2.** Provide monthly trainings and increase material distribution.
- **03.** Increase Naloxone Distribution by 25%
- **04.** Support internal capacity to increase access to harm reduction services.
- **05.** Enhance access to harm reduction supplies through vending machines and community boxes.
- 06. Provide HIV/HCV testing to identify and reduce the spread of communicable disease and increase the likelihood of Treatment

Expand access to Peer Support Specialists in jail and prison systems.




Engage Justice-involved individuals 90 days (about 3 months) pre-release.



Create outreach materials through video and print materials.

ADDRESS SOCIAL DETERMINANTS OF HEALTH



- **01.** Address barriers to transportation
- **Q2.** Increase access to Medication Assisted Treatment
- **03.** Reduce Food Insecurity and Increase access to healthy foods.
- **Q4.** Increase access to housing including expansion of Phases Transition Housing Program
- 05. Increase access to basic needs for underserved
- **06.** Increase access to human hygiene i.e., showers, washers, and dryers for unhoused population
- **07.** Increase the access to paid therapeutic workplace opportunities

Purchase and renovate property and buildings associated with expanding access to treatment for underserved individuals with substance use disorders in North Carolina.


