The cost of the miniature dachshund puppy is \$2500-\$3000 and, if approved, will be required to be paid upon pickup. Cost includes all taxes. A deposit of \$500 may be required if holding a puppy for two weeks or more. If paying by personal check I would need to receive this check two weeks prior to pickup so that it clears the bank prior to our puppy leaving. At pickup, any balance remaining is due by either cash or credit card. No cash apps will be used. No payment plans are offered. If paying by credit card there is an additional 2.6% fee on top of the payment price. Transportation is not included in the sale price. I will meet within a 4 hour drive of Spokane WA. Any other transportation costs will be paid by buyer.

What breeds and sexes? Are they altered (spay/neuter)?

Any other pets other than dogs (inside and outside)? What type?

Have you owned dachshunds before?

What is your knowledge of the dachshund and what are your reasons for choosing one now?

Are you aware of the socialization and training needs of a dachshund puppy and do you feel that you are capable of providing these needs?

Is your yard fenced or do you have a fenced enclosure for the dog?

If you answered “no”, how do you intend to exercise and provide security for this puppy?

How large and what type is the enclosure?

Do you let your dogs run loose and under what circumstances?

Do you intend to house your dog inside or outside?

Have you ever used a crate to confine your dog? We do recommend that puppies be crate trained and we start this training before they leave our home.

Are you willing to have the puppy's health checked on a yearly basis at the least?

Do you prefer your dog to be male or female?

Please give us two references (name and phone number) of people that know or have known you and your dog/pets.

AKC registration for all dachshund placed as companion pets will be marked as "non-breeding" with limited registration. Do you have any reservations about this policy?

If so, please tell us about your reservations.

Do you intend to spay or neuter your puppy?

Provide the name, address, and telephone number of your veterinarian as a reference.

Are you currently on the waiting list for any other litters?
