

Guide to Completing IPP Survey Form (points in question)

Section 1

Survey Map Attached: Yes. (Please attach map provided with sector assignment)

MIDAS #: 4340

Sectors/Location: Use assigned sector (T1-A, T1-B etc. - may include more than one per form)

Infestation Surveillance: Do not check

Regional Affiliation: N/A

Name of Lake Team: Toddy Pond Association

For Multi-year surveys: N/A

Survey Level: Level 3, by sector

Visual Methods: Transects

Grab Sample Methods: Target points

Invasive Plant/s Targeted: Complete list, all eleven invaders

Additional Survey Goals: Inventory of dominant native plants by sector

Section 2

Suspected IAP (Invasive Aquatic Plant) observed : Mark “N” if None, mark “Y” if suspicious plant is submitted to Section Captain or IPP leader or Hancock City Soil and Water.

IAP Code (two letter code next to invasives listed, ex. EM for Eurasian milfoil.

Section 3 (reverse side)

One column for each Sector completed (some patrollers are assigned more than one sector). Note notations top of page.

If you only know the general name of a plant, ie. pondweed, mark ‘pondweed, spp.’

Section 4

This section is for other species of concern. Ex. Chinese mystery snail, zebra mussels, quagga mussels, Didymo (rock snot), rusty crayfish, Northern pike
