For us that light came in the form of Boxes sent from Anthem, AZ.

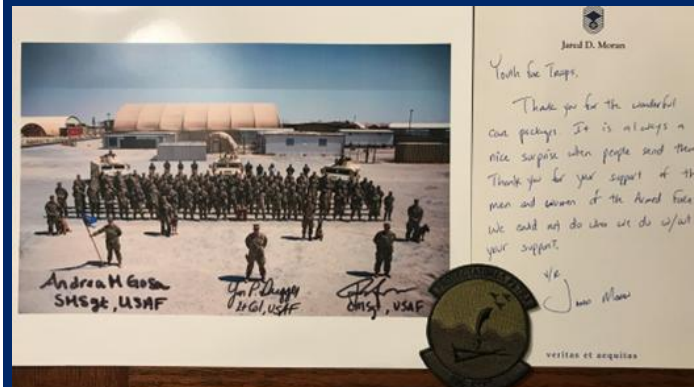

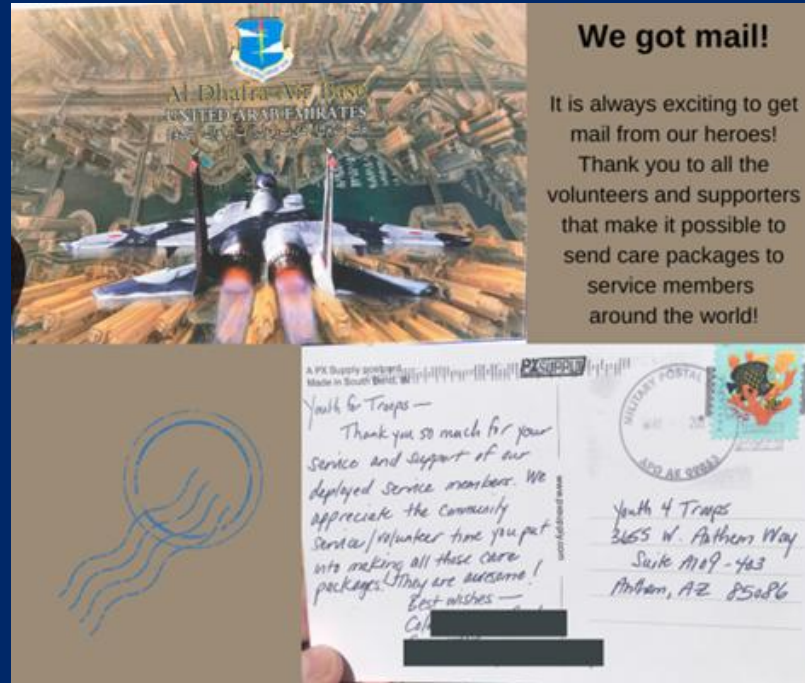


Hello,
