In the next few weeks when you open the Metro Women's Club website you will be advised that the website uses cookies. Please tap or click on "ACCEPT" to access the website.

What are cookies? An internet cookie is a small piece of data that a website stores on a user's browser. A cookie consists of a small text file with a unique ID which is an anonymous randomly generated number. There are two copies of it, one is stored on your device and one is stored on the website.

What are internet cookies used for?

Cookies are an important component that helps websites to function effectively. Cookies enable you to use basic features on the website and allow sites to personalize user experience, track how users browse the site and collect insights for improving the site, products and services.

Most often, websites use cookies to:

- **Track how users interact with a website**
- Keep you logged in on the site
- Remember items in your shopping cart or wishlist
- Keep your payment information secure
- Personalize the content you see
- Save your preferred site settings and themes
- Show users relevant, personalized ads

THIS WEBSITE USES COOKIES.

We use cookies to analyze website traffic and optimize your website experience. By accepting our use of cookies, your data will be aggregated with all other user data.

ACCEPT

We are trying to understand who uses our website, what pages they frequent and the city where they are located. We are not collecting any personl data on anyone that uses the website.

The website will not force a cookie acceptance prompt for visitors every time the site is accessed. Instead, a consent pop-up appears on a visitor's **first visit** to comply with privacy regulations. Once a visitor accepts, their choice is saved, so they are not asked repeatedly. Although, it is possible that if you access the website on different devices that the first time you use each device you will be asked to accept the use of cookies.
