#### HOLIDAY COLLECTION OF CANS FOR LEAST OF MY BRETHREN

As you may know, Least of My Brethren offers a bag of empty used cans and plastic bottles to their clients. These cans and bottles are recycled in Iowa for cash. Metro Women's Club would like to help with these recyclables this holiday season. If you could, please save these items through the holidays and we will collect them and take them to Least of My Brethren's warehouse. Here is a description of what can be saved:

"We can take any kind of uncrushed soda cans, beer cans, or plastic bottles such as Pepsi plastic bottles. We do not take water bottles, juice bottles, Gatorade and so on. Any bag at all will work just fine. We typically bag them up and distribute one bag of cans to each individual."

If you decide to collect these items over the holidays, please plan on bringing them to the January Social Noon Luncheon on Tuesday, January 9th. #### **INCLEMENT WEATHER POLICY**

- 1. Activities: When Omaha Schools are closed, or switched to remote learning, Metro Women's Club activities are also cancelled, ie. Bunco, Bridge, Mah Jongg, etc.
- Luncheons: When Omaha Schools are closed or switched to remote learning, our luncheons are cancelled, <u>only if they are at a Restaurant</u>.
