Dear Metro Women's Club Members, On Tuesday, December 20th there was a meeting of the Executive Board to discuss a major concern about our club, the ever-increasing membership, and the problems this is creating. This includes being more difficult to find venues that can hold us for our monthly luncheons and too many closed special interest groups. It seems we are not meeting the needs of our current members.

With this awareness, the Executive Board voted and approved three motions. The first was to put a moratorium on current new membership. I am writing on behalf of the Metro Women's Club. The Metro Women's Club is organized for social and charitable causes, including the making of contributions to charitable organizations and/or participation in promotional support of community, civic and service projects. We began 50 years ago and are currently a club of over 200 members.
