INCLEMENT WEATHER POLICY

- 1. **Activities:** When Omaha Schools are closed, or switch to remote learning, Metro Women's Club activities are also canceled, ie. Bunco, Bridge, MahJongg, etc. If school is out due to a holiday, hostess makes a safety decision.
- 2. **Luncheons:** When Omaha Schools are closed or switch to remote learning, our luncheons are canceled, <u>only if they are at a Restaurant</u>. All Luncheons held at a private catered venue, such as Arbor Hall, **are not canceled**. If the venue is a private catered venue you will be charged for your luncheon if you are a no-show.
- 3. **Board Meetings: Board Meetings are an exception to the Omaha School closing rule.** Board Meetings will only be canceled if travel is not recommended by our Police Department, Mayor Office or our Roads Department. In this case the meeting will be held by our President via Zoom. If weather is a problem, Officers and Chairpersons must email their Newsletter information to Marcelene Lewis. The Newsletter must still go out no matter the weather.
