ANNUAL PICNIC AND GARAGE SALE AT CHALCO HILLS "GROUP SHELTER" JUNE 14TH 2022, 11:30 AM

Directions:

Enter Chalco Hills Recreation Area at 154th & Giles Road.

Go approximately 0.2 miles to the 1st Stop Sign.

1st STOP SIGN turn **Right** (park sign shows an arrow pointing to "Boat Ramp" but you will be going passed the Boat Ramp).

Continue on road for approximately 0.2 miles to 2nd STOP SIGN.

2nd STOP SIGN turn **Right**. Park sign shows arrow pointing towards "Picnic Area".

Continue for approximately 0.7 miles on a winding road.

"GROUP SHELTER" is the <u>1st left turn you can make off the winding road</u>. There is a sign with an arrow pointing to Picnic area about 25 feet before you turn left. Also, many reflective discs on poles mark turn.

That's it !!! Two rights and then a left.

Tuesday, June 14th at 11:30 AM, RAIN OR SHINE

Bring your favorite beverage, bottled water will be provided. Please bring <u>pre-priced</u> sale items. This is our first fund raiser for our new Charity, Omaha Street School, so bring your best garage sale items.

Our picnic is held at a very large covered shelter with electrical outlets, flat paved surfaces, no steps, ample parking, with restroom close by. Ladies, please let our gals that have ambulatory difficulties park next to the shelter's entrance. We will have a beautiful view of the lake with lots of wild life. Balloons will mark each turn.
