INCLEMENT WEATHER POLICY

- 1. Activities: When Omaha Schools are closed, or switched to remote learning, Metro Women's Club activities are also cancelled, ie. Bunco, Bridge, MahJongg, etc.
- 2. Luncheons: When Omaha Schools are closed or switched to remote learning, our luncheons are cancelled, <u>only if they are at a</u> <u>Restaurant</u>. All Luncheons held at a private catered venue, such as Arbor Hall, are not cancelled. If the venue is a private catered venue you will be charged for your luncheon if you are a no-show.
- 3. Board Meetings: Board Meetings are an exception to the Omaha School closing rule. Board Meetings will only be cancelled if travel is not recommended by our Police Department, Mayor's Office and/or our Roads Department.
