We were given a tour of the home and met some of its residents. At the end of our tour, we visited with Miss Kayla and Miss Jeanette about other specific needs that might be useful. Diapers (newborn, small, large and pull ups), baby wipes, 300/500 piece puzzles and adult coloring books were mentioned. CHH (7815 Harney Street) is open 24/7, so items can be delivered at any time. If you choose to donate specific items individually, take your ID and identify yourself as being with Metro Women's Club.

What a wonderful mission CHH has and what a difference they are making in the lives of young adults. Below is a testimony from one of the women.

"I just moved in as of 12/30/25, so it's officially been 8 days. It's nice to have some sort of a routine that is NOT a jail routine and that does NOT involve the use of drugs and alcohol. The girls so far are pretty friendly and have been pretty welcoming. I'm looking forward to get my son back from the State and I know that Carole's House of Hope is the perfect place for me to be currently. I can't wait to use all the resources they have available and I also can't wait to be stable and be on my own with my little family creating new adventures."


