The Burdell Building was constructed in 1897 by the Burdell family and would become a hub for Petaluma's poultry and dairy industry.

It served as a cold storage / ice production facility / an electric company. Now restored it serves as a home for many small businesses.

Directions: From Petaluma boulevard take D street across the railroad tracks, cross Lakeville street, look for the first driveway on the left side. Public parking is available for the dedication.

Per Capita Tax Set at \$55.62

The 2023-2024 budget submitted by incoming Grand President George Adams calls for a total expenditure of \$345,085 with deductions of \$35,748, making \$309,337 the amount for the per capita tax. Based on current membership, this resulted in a per capita tax of \$55.62. Total for the general items budget is \$126,433, a reduction of \$11,299 resulting mainly from virtually eliminating the budget for The Native Son and entirely eliminating the Legal Fund amount
