Voting on candidates

INSTRUCT THE MARSHAL TO BRING THE CANDIDATES TO THE ALTAR. WHEN THEY ARE THERE, THE PRESIDENT SAYS:

President: - My friend(s), before you proceed further, it is necessary for you to take that solemn vow which binds us all. It is not in conflict but is in harmony with those exalted duties you owe to your God, your country and yourself. Let it not be lightly taken, lest it be lightly broken, for your claims to manhood are shattered when you have either willfully or carelessly broken it. Are you now ready to take such an obligation? WHEN THEY ANSWER YES, TWO RAPS.

Jr. Past President: - You will place your left hand over your heart, raise your right hand, and repeat after me the following obligation. THREE RAPS.

AFTER THE JUNIOR PAST PRESIDENT CONCLUDES THE OBLIGATION WITH "so help me, God" and instructs the candidates to lower their hands, ONE RAP

Ask the sponsors to place the pins on the new members. Explain to the new members the salute and give them the permanent and semi-annual passwords. Instruct them not to cross between the altar and the station of the president during a meeting. Show them the proper salute when addressing the president.

Ask the new members to introduce themselves and tell what they do for a living. Then instruct the Marshal to escort the new brothers to seats in the hall.
