The Housing Action Plan provides guidance to the City on specific actions and initiatives to undertake in order to meet Des Moines' housing need.

Appeals must be complete and filed with the City Clerk by 4:30 p.m., on June 5, 2023. The appeal letter must cite specific procedural errors, omissions, environmental impacts, inaccurate environmental information or failure to comply with specific adopted policies or codes which dispute the validity of the DNS.		
PUBLIC HEARING:	Notice is also hereby given that the Des Moines City Council will conduct a <u>Public Hearing</u> on <u>June 1, 2023</u> at 6:00 p.m., or as soon thereafter as the matter may be heard.
