Introduction:

Mission Statement:

Vision Statement:

League Venue Policy:

Unacceptable activities will be addressed by the league referees.

Activities - Activities that are unwholesome or are not supported by the venues we inhabit will not be permitted on any properties. At any time, the use of the church / school property is subject to review. If any information about an activity or rental is brought to our attention even after a rental agreement has been processed, we reserve the right to cancel the agreement. Ordained Leadership or Board of Elders may be asked to help discern any questionable use of the church / school property.

Dancing – No forms of secular dancing will be permitted in any part of the church / school property.

Smoking – Smoking is not permitted on church / school property.

Alcohol or Illegal Drugs – Alcohol or illegal drugs in any form are not permitted on the church / school property.

Language – No foul or abusive language will be permitted at any time on the church / school property.

Gambling - No form of gambling (e.g. bingo or games of chance) will be permitted on the church / school property.

Music – Since the building and property have been dedicated to the honor and glory of God, no secular music, vocal or instrumental, will be permitted on church or school property without approval. All music must be played at a reasonable level at all times and must not interfere with other activities that might be held at the same time in another part of the facility.

Violations of these rules and regulations will automatically terminate use of the facility for those individuals or groups.

We take every reservation seriously and intend to reliably facilitate all reservations as per agreement, however we reserve the right to deny or cancel any reservation for any reason.

Schedule Info:

The 2023 - 2024 league consists of 9 teams. Each team will play 10 season games. The top two teams after the regular season ends will have a first round bye in the playoffs. The bottom three teams after the regular season ends will not make the playoffs. Teams will be seeded for their playoff matchups. See schedule on website.

Trophies:

Trophies will be presented at the end of the playoffs for the following categories.

- · Championship trophy
- Championship rings
- Runner up
- League MVP (regular season) Players to vote on recipient.
- Sportsmanship (regular season) The referees will be choosing the recipient.
- Scoring Champion (regular season) The player with the highest total score will be the recipient.
- Sharpshooter (regular season) The player with the most 3 pointers will be the recipient.
- Defensive Player of the Year (regular season) Players to vote on recipient.
- Most improved player.

Game Format:

Game time: 2-20 minute halves running clock. Clock stops last 2 minutes of each half.

Over time: 1-5 minute period running clock. Clock stops last minute.

2nd Overtime: First basket wins.

Timeouts: 4-30 second timeouts per game.

Roster Info:

Roster: Each team will be able to have up to 12 players on their roster.

Playoff qualification: To be eligible for the playoffs, each player must make 4 regular season games. This is tracked by the league and will be enforced by the referees. Team captains are responsible for checking off "present" box on scorecard.

Fouls:

- 6th foul is disqualification
- 1 on 1 for 7 team fouls
- 2 shots for 10 team fouls
- 1st Technical foul 1 shot and the ball
- 2nd technical foul for same person equals disqualification

Technical foul description

- 1. Infraction for unsportsmanlike conduct such as arguing with a referee or belittling another person.
- 2. Cursing if directed to a certain referee or individual or very vocal that all can hear.
- 3. Overly aggressive physical contact above the standard play of the game.
