

Format: Two-Round Scramble

- This tournament will be played as a scramble format for both rounds.
- All players tee off; the team selects the best shot.
- All teammates play their next shot from that selected position.
- Continue this process until the ball is holed.
- Every putt must be holed. No gimmies.

Drop & Placement Rules (Scramble Simplification)

- All balls must be dropped within one scorecard length of the selected ball.
- Drops must be:
 - No closer to the hole
 - In the same condition (fairway stays fairway, rough stays rough, etc.)
- You may never improve your lie (no moving from rough to fairway, bunker to grass, etc.).

Out of Bounds (OB) — Pace of Play Rule

To speed up play, the following local rule is in effect:

- Option 1: Re-hit from previous spot
 - 1-stroke penalty
 - Team re-hits from the prior position.
- Option 2: Drop in fairway
 - 2-stroke penalty
 - Team may drop the ball in the middle of the fairway closest to where the ball crossed the OB line.
 - This option is intended for pace of play and may be used instead of re-hitting.

Note: Under standard golf rules, a drop is not normally allowed for OB. This tournament intentionally allows this local rule to keep play moving.

Hazard Rules (Clarified)

Red Hazards (●)

- Play as it lies, or
- 1-stroke penalty and choose one:
 - Stroke and distance
 - Back-on-the-line relief
 - Lateral relief within two club lengths, no closer to the hole

Yellow Hazards (●)

- Play as it lies, or

- 1-stroke penalty and choose one:
 - Stroke and distance
 - Back-on-the-line relief
- No lateral drop allowed for yellow hazards.

Cart Paths

- Free relief is allowed from any cart path, defined as:
 - Paved paths
 - Gravel paths
 - Dirt paths regularly used by golf carts
- Drop within one scorecard length, no closer to the hole.

Scoring

- Scores are recorded as total team score.
- Exchange scorecards with the team you are playing with.
- Turn in scorecards immediately after each round.

General Conduct

- Play ready golf.
- Maintain pace of play.
- Respect course staff and fellow competitors.
- Tournament officials have final say on all rulings.
