

## General Guide

- Press **C** to change from mode to mode.
- In any mode (except when a setting screen is on the display), press **B** to illuminate the display.

### Timekeeping Mode World Time Mode






## Timekeeping



The Timekeeping Mode's Multi Time feature gives you quick and easy access to the current time and date in four different cities, numbered from T-1 (Time 1) through T-4 (Time 4). T-1 is your Home City Time, and T-2, T-3, and T-4 are Local Times. Local Times are kept in synchronization with your Home City Time (T-1). The digital dial at the top of the screen indicates the current Home City Time (T-1). For details on reading the map and digital dial, see "Map and Digital Dial" (page E-30).

### Switching Between Time Screens

Each press of **D** cycles the time screens in the sequence shown below.





- While the Home City Time (T-1) screen is displayed, pressing **A** will switch the day of the week / month-day indication to the currently selected Home City code and the T-1 indicator for about one second.
- You can change the current time setting for your Home City Time (T-1) only.
- For Local Times (T-2, T-3, T-4), you only can change the city code and DST setting.

### Changing the Current Home City Time and Date Settings

- Use **D** to display the current Home City Time (T-1) screen.
- Hold down **A** until the seconds start to flash, which indicates the setting screen.
- Press **C** to move the flashing in the sequence shown below to select other settings.



- When the setting you want to change is flashing, use **D** and **B** to change it as described below.
