Course Description:

EMR Refresher: This 16-hour course is designed to offer the certified EMRs a pathway to maintain his/her certification. This course will reinforce basic EMS knowledge and offer a review of any changes to this level of practice. Teaching methods will include classroom instruction and skills verification. The student will have the opportunity to recertify his/her BLS as part of this course.

EMT Refresher: This 40-hour continuing education course follows the EMT National Continued Competency Program (NCCP) for recertification. This model is separated into three components: (1) national component, (2) local/state component, and (3) individual component. This course will reinforce previously acquired prehospital knowledge and offer a review of any changes to this level of practice. Teaching methods will include classroom instruction and skills verification. The student will have the opportunity to recertify his/her BLS as part of this course.

AEMT Refresher: This 50-hour continuing education course follows the Advanced EMT National Continued Competency Program (NCCP) for recertification. This model requires continuing education in three components: (1) national component, (2) local/state component, and (3) individual component. This course will reinforce previously acquired basic and advanced prehospital knowledge and offer a review of any changes to this level of practice. Teaching methods will include classroom instruction and skills verification. The student will have the opportunity to recertify his/her BLS, ACLS, and PALS as part of this course.

Paramedic Refresher: This 60-hour continuing education course follows the Paramedic National Continued Competency Program (NCCP) for recertification. The model requires continuing education in three components: (1) national component, (2) local/state component, and (3) individual component. This course will reinforce previously acquired advanced prehospital knowledge and offer a review of any changes to this level of practice. Teaching methods will include classroom instruction and skills verification. The student will have the opportunity to recertify his/her BLS, ACLS, and PALS as part of this course.
