
There Will Be Blood





What I take away from these headlines are the following:

- 1. The apostasy and falling away that Paul speaks of in 1 Timothy 4:1 and 2 Thessalonians 2:3 are in full swing.
- 2. The judgment plucking of the eagle's (United States) wings of the first western beast of Daniel 7 is in full swing.
- 3. The preparations by the bear (Russia) and the leopard (China) of the second northern and third eastern beasts of Daniel 7 to overtake the first western beast are in full swing.

4. The persecution of the American Church and the global Church are ramping up to go into full swing.

Contempt for the Church here in the US is rising, and outright hostility and violence have been on the rise over the last decade. Churches have been attacked by gun-wielding murderers, churches have been burned, and churches have been vandalized. Christians are being oppressed in the workplace, passed over for promotions and raises, or censured or fired for their religious and political beliefs. We are mocked in the media. Even foreigners have thrown themselves into the contemptualization fray, as one complained to me, "Although I believe most Evangelical doctrines, I in no way want to be identified with American Evangelicals. They are an embarrassment to the Gospel and Christianity in general." We are being marginalized and contemptualized just as the Jews were in Nazi Germany and just as the Tutsis were in Rwanda. Let that thought take you to its logical conclusion.

Amazing, yet not so much if one considers the state of the Church here in America. Amazing in the sense that, contrary to all the lame, lying assertions that secularists make to deny our founding principles, this nation was founded under God. For instance, the east face of the capstone on the Washington Monument has the Latin words "Laus Deo," which translate to, "Praise be to God." Our currency references trust in God. Half or more of the signers of the Constitution had some form of divinity school training, since the colleges of their time emphasized training of pastors. The Bible was commonly used for teaching English grammar and world history in classrooms of past centuries. Both Yale and Harvard were founded by clergy, meaning Christian leadership.

Yet, not so much amazing in the sense that we have become as Israel prior to its various judgments: fleshly, hedonistic, apostate, "ear ticklers," false prophets, divisive, lethargic toward the Lord, heretical. Observe John MacArthur's YouTube video headline above stating that it's too late for America. I agree. As he points out in the video, when a nation becomes like what Paul describes in Romans 1, i.e., when God "gave them over" and "gave them up," rest assured it will be no different for US. The writer of Hebrews (I'm convinced it was Paul) said that God is the same yesterday, today, and forever. Moreover, Paul said that God is not mocked – whatsoever a man sows, that will he also reap. It is the same with nations.

What does this have to do with the title of this article? Everything. There will be blood in the streets of this nation in the very near future, and even now it is occurring. Even the Australians have noticed the dangerous trend toward tyranny, as the first page upper left photo shows. But the blood spilling of the future will be of epic proportions, in the same way it was for Israel when Assyria and Babylon carried them away and, in modern times, in the same way it was for the Jews of Europe and the Tutsis of Rwanda. As Peter said, judgment begins with the house of God, so that much of the blood will be that of Christians.

This is a hard saying. Some cannot accept it. One reader complained to me that one of my articles about the Church's coming judgment and suffering gave no hope, and she threw in a personal

insult for good measure - so much for speaking the truth in love. But I adjudged her comments to have no truth: our hope is in Jesus, not the absence of suffering. As Paul said, "For I reckon that the sufferings of this present time are not worthy to be compared with the glory which shall be revealed in us." (Romans 8:18) I'm hard pressed to understand why millions of Christians over the past 2,000 years have suffered excruciating pain and death for their faith, yet we end-timers are supposed to be given a pass. Utter nonsense, foolish, and dangerous.

This is my last monograph of the writing campaign that started with the Charisma advertising campaign beginning late 2019. I must move on to more pressing concerns with my family and my company. I leave the audience with these thoughts that are reiterations of the major points I made from 2019 until now.

- 1. There will be no pre-Tribulation rapture. It is a false doctrine that gives false hope. I know of what I speak, since I came out of that movement and experienced first-hand how it built some complacency in me and many Christians I have encountered through the years.
- 2. Daniel 7 has nothing to do with the ancient nations of Babylon, Medo-Persia, Greece, or Rome and is not a reiteration of Daniel 2.
- 3. The United States is in Bible prophecy, and it has nothing to do with Mystery Babylon. We, along with the Brits, are the first lion-eagle beast of Daniel 7 that will fall, but we, and possibly the Brits, will rise again as a repentant nation or nations.
- 4. The Russians, with their Iranian, Turkish, and Syrian allies, are the second bear-three ribs beast of Daniel 7 that will be destroyed in the war against Israel of Ezekiel 38 and 39. Gog and Magog are Russian, not Turkish.
- 5. The Chinese and probably the Japanese and Koreans, both North and South, are the third leopard with four heads and four wings beast of Daniel 7 that will likely be defeated by the fourth "diverse" leopard-lion-bear antichrist beast of Daniel 7 and Revelation 13:2 as a precursor to his rise to global dominance.
- 6. Daniel 2 is strictly about ancient nations culminating with the Islamic and Ottoman Empires that no longer exist. Daniel 2 has nothing to do with a Revived Roman Empire or a Revived Islamic Empire. The European Union will not morph into the antichrist's kingdom, and Muslim nations will cease to exist as major threats to anyone after their defeats in the Psalm 83 and Ezekiel 38-39 wars, both of which precede the Tribulation.
- 7. The antichrist will be from Mosul (Nineveh) in present-day Iraq. He will be a replay of prior kings from Assyria and Babylon who were pre-types of the antichrist, who is called the Assyrian and the king of Babylon in the Old Testament. He will not be Turkish or European.

In closing, I pray the Body of Christ here in America will wake up to the urgency of the moment to prepare for the coming holocaust in this nation.
