Let's continue to do great things in the Kingdom this year!

Don't forget our Christmas Eve service. It starts at 6:00.

The last message of the year is titled *Patient Endurance*. Closing out an old year should cause a disciple of Jesus to review the past and prepare for the future. Text: Rom 15.4-6

For whatever was written in former days was written for our instruction, that through endurance and through the encouragement of the Scriptures we might have hope. May the God of endurance and encouragement grant you to live in such harmony with one another, in accord with Christ Jesus, that together you may with one voice glorify the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ.

These are the other key Scriptures I will study to build the message. Some scripture that you may want to study and marinate in your heart. A disciple's journey is not a run; it is a long slow walk with the Savior.

But as servants of God we commend ourselves in every way: by great endurance, in afflictions, hardships, calamities, beatings, imprisonments, riots, labors, sleepless nights, hunger; by purity, knowledge, patience, kindness, the Holy Spirit, genuine love; by truthful speech, and the power of God; with the weapons of righteousness for the right hand and for the left; through honor and dishonor, through slander and praise. We are treated as impostors, and yet are true; as unknown, and yet well known; as dying, and behold, we live; as punished, and yet not killed; 10 as sorrowful, yet always rejoicing; as poor, yet making many rich; as having nothing, yet possessing everything. 2 Cor 6.4-10

Being strengthened with all power, according to his glorious might, for all endurance and patience with joy; 12 giving thanks to the Father, who has qualified you to share in the inheritance of the saints in light. Col 1.11-12

For you have need of endurance, so that when you have done the will of God you may receive what is promised. Heb 10.36
