Joining the true vine

Reading and meditating on John 15 this morning, I thought about the beginnings of attaching to the true vine, grafting into the original tree of faith (Abraham's linage of faith), where we are nourished by its pure root. (Rom 11.17-18.)

Remain in me, as I also remain in you. No branch can bear fruit by itself; it must remain in the vine. Neither can you bear fruit unless you remain in me.

"I am the vine; you are the branches. If you remain in me and I in you, you will bear much fruit; apart from me you can do nothing. John 15.4-5 (NIV)

Grafting into the true vine is believing the incarnation of Jesus. The first step in God's plan of salvation is faith. Our confession of faith is," I believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of the living God." An authentic and heartfelt confession of faith in Jesus and his Father is the beginning of the journey. It is a journey of growth in and service to the kingdom. Spiritual health comes from attachment to the true vine; then, one has opportunities to accomplish the works that accompany faith: love, charity, mercy, justice.
