



## **God Can Because God Knows Job 42.2**

*“I know that you can do all things,  
and that no purpose of yours can be thwarted.”*

**The Point: God can do his will for his people because he knows our needs before we do.**

**The Question: So, why fast, pray, and ask?**

**Job says to God; you can do all things.”**

**God has a perfect understanding**

**God knows his people and who will be his people**

**He is there for every trial, guiding our way and guiding us back when we have times of doubt.**

Brother Job had a rough year. The estimated timeline for Job’s trial is nine to twenty-four months. He lost children, property, estate, and there were boils and itching. His wife called him a fool for honoring God and keeping his spiritual integrity. His three friends did not show him compassion or pity. Instead, they tried to convince him he was a sinner deserving punishment. God does not allow trials to see how we do—he knows—he shows the sufferer and observers and others how they do in the test. In trials, we feel the touch of the Master’s hand.

God hears every whisper and cry of prayer—formal and informal. I judge informal prayer as most important. God sees every step, whether in light or darkness. No, God does not have the five senses, but he *observes* all; God knows the past perfectly, *sees* the present in minute detail, and has a perfect vision of the future.
