From my morning devotional time, I read Psalm 25, Isaiah 63-64, and Matthew 13.

There is judgment and the mercy of grace in Isaiah. Matthew told Jesus' parables of the soils, wheat and weeds, mustard seed and leaven, pearl, buried treasure, and his explanations of these parables. My heart settled on, and I pondered Psalm 25.12:

Who is the man who fears the Lord? Him will he instruct in the way that he should choose. (ESV)

The preacher came to a saving knowledge of the LORD based on fear of eternal punishment—I didn't want to go to hell! But, that fear turned into a healthy respect for his holiness. That respect blossomed into a deep and abiding love for him as a person. So, how does he guide the one who fears him?

God instructs us in three ways. First, through his holy Word, read and meditated on the phrases that seem to float to the surface. Second, testing and circumstances will provide instructions on the path he is guiding you. Lastly— and I find this remarkable when it happens—unexpected advice from a sister or brother in Christ on what has been on your soul. The preacher had a couple of spoons of that broth last week. The broth was soothing to my soul. Even seemingly "hot" words, taken with grace, can guide and direct us to the right path.
