From my morning devotional time, I read Psalm 31, Jeremiah 11-12, and Romans 3-4.

Psa 31.1 reads, "In you, O LORD, do I take refuge; let me never be put to shame; in your righteousness deliver me!" and Psalm 31.5 "Into your hand I commit my spirit." But, of course, this takes my mind and heart to the cross of Jesus and Luke 23.46, "Then Jesus, calling out with a loud voice, said, "Father, into your hands I commit my spirit!" And having said this he breathed his last."

Occasionally, I read the Hebrew bedtime prayers at night, and in them, one commits their soul to the LORD's care during sleep and dreams. Will one wake in the morning? One does not know. It is a comfort to place my unconscious time into the hand of the LORD. Another thought, how many times have you asked someone to pray "travel mercies" for your vacation travel? What will today or tomorrow bring?

What does it matter what tomorrow will bring to the believer in the risen Lord Jesus? First, read Romans 4.13-25, so my comments on verses 24-25 will be understood in the context. Jesus died because you and I are sinners. His death is only necessary because of human sin. "It will be counted to us who believe in him who raised from the dead our Lord, who was delivered up for our trespasses and raised for our justification." His blood paid the price, and his resurrection made him a risen Lord. He ascended into heaven and will return. If one believes Jesus died for their sin and rose from the grave, their salvation is genuinely in Christ. Therefore, there is no need to worry about what today or tomorrow will bring. Sleep well!
