Sermon Notes for March 19, 2023 Spiritual Warfare 4 Stand and Defend! Eph 6.13-17 We encourage you to watch the worship service and message on our YouTube channel

Therefore take up the whole armor of God, that you may be able to withstand in the evil day, and having done all, to stand firm. Eph 6.13

The Point: We have a powerful adversary; resistance to his schemes is a congregational concern.

The Question: Isn't Ephesians 6.10-20 just for the individual disciple?

We move from individual spiritual warfare and defense to congregational. If the individual is subject to attack, why not the congregation they serve? (2 Tim 2.24-26, 1 John 2.18-19, Rev 2.9-10) Satan demanded to sift the disciples as wheat, and Jesus prayed for them. (Luke 22.31-32) The enemy knows his end. He aims to be a thorn that daily grieves God's Heart. Every lost soul causes pain and every saved one is joy.

Our adversary and his two armies Our adversary has two armies, one spiritual and the other physical. The spiritual army is made of angels that rebelled against God (Jude 1.6). Some demonologists say Satan deceived many of them to rebel. His schemes and deceptions precede the fall of Adam and Eve. He is a created being that seeks to deceive other created beings.

The second army is humans who willingly or unconsciously follow his lead. The first named human recruit is Cain. (Gen 4) Billions have followed him to the grave. Some of his recruits actively fight against the Church of the living God. Our spiritual foes work against the believer's heart, mind, and body and can cause one to work as a distraction to good order and practices.

Do you stand alone or with others on your right and left? A congregation is God's design for spiritual growth, evangelism, and defense. We help ourselves and our congregation (fellowship) when we work as a team. A disciple of Jesus should not walk or work alone. Jesus sent his disciples out in groups of two (Luke 10); elders in a church are always mentioned in the plural Acts 14.23, 1 Tim 4.14, and 5.17. Paul always had a team of at least three. A church evangelism call should be a team of two.

What groups of potential defense does a congregation have? Here are a few: Sunday morning Bible study, ladies' monthly meeting, men's monthly breakfast, online prayer, and Bible study. I miss Sunday evening worship and Wednesday evening prayer groups—a bygone era. Multiply your shields, swords, helmets, and boots!

Does a congregation stand alone? (sadly, many do) Congregations should team up to defend their community with prayers, good works, and acts of faith. Sadly, many congregations function like they are solitary islands.

Stand together, and the LORD stands with you. Matt 18.20 "For where two or three are gathered in my name, there am I among them."
