

COMPETITION INFO 2026 AGE 8+

COMMITMENT

Competition teams require a high level of commitment. Excessive absences or missing a competition may impact the team and can result in removal from the competition group.

This program is not suitable for families with many other commitments.

Competition weekends are advised well in advance, however exact days and times may not be confirmed until the week of.

Families should keep these weekends free. If you are unavailable, senior dancers with full licences may be able to assist with transport.

PAY BY TERM

Competition classes are paid by the term because they require consistent attendance and ongoing choreography that builds week to week.

Teachers plan and commit to the full term, and choreography is created specifically for a confirmed team size, so pay as you go isn't suitable for this style of training.

AUDITIONS

All dancers wishing to join the competition team must attend a compulsory open age training on Monday 9th February from 4.45-5.45pm. *This session is included in the \$150 term fee and is not a viewing day.*

COMPETITIONS

Seniors will aim to attend 3-4 competitions per year, with juniors attending 2-3 competitions in their first year. Competition dancers will also perform in the Junior Concert with no additional rehearsal fees.

19th July & 13th September are competition we hope to attend.

Dance style is chosen by the teacher.
