HAIR - NEAT BALLET BUN

HOW TO DO A NEAT BALLET BUN

- Start with damp hair spray lightly with water or smooth in some gel/hairspray to control flyaways.
- Brush it back gather hair into a high ponytail (around the crown of the head) and secure tightly with a hair elastic.
- Twist the ponytail gently twist the hair until it coils.
- Wrap into a bun wind the twisted ponytail around the base, forming a flat bun.
- Secure with pins use bobby pins or hairpins all the way around,
 close to the scalp, to hold it in place.
- Net & spray pop a hairnet over the bun (same colour as hair), then
 add more pins if needed. Finish with hairspray to keep it neat.
 - * Tips for little ones:
- Sit them in front of the TV or give them a toy/book while you do it.
- If hair is very fine, use a bit of mousse/gel before starting.
- A bun donut or a cut sock can help if the hair is very short or thin.
