NO EXCEPTIONS
  - 6. SUBMIT SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION IN A CLEAR FOLDER.
  - 7. SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATIONS ARE DUE NO LATER THAN MONDAY THE LAST DAY OF CHECK IN AT THE STATE RODEO OFFICE. SCHOLARSHIPS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED AFTER 12:00 P.M. NOON ON MONDAY!!!
  - 8. <u>APPLICANTS</u> going on a <u>mission or serving in the military, scholarships will be held for 30 months.</u> <u>Military applicants can ask for an extension.</u>
