### **Scholarship Opportunities**

- 3. After reviewing all applications, the Scholarship Committee will contact all applicants by phone and post it on the website. The scholarship recipients will be invited to the presentation of awards during a worship service in June by Father Simon. Recipients are expected to attend this presentation. If unable to attend, the student must contact the chairperson of the Scholarship Committee prior to the awards service.
- 4. This application is for one academic school year.
