

Our scenic 7 mile loop.

- 1. Start the trail by heading over the boardwalk bridge next to the bike stand. This will take you to Lake Evalyn, go around the lake and you will find another boardwalk this boardwalk brings you out to a lake where you can see the backs of multimillion dollar custom homes. When you come to the end of this lake you will ride up another wooden bridge.
- 2. Take a left turn along Oak Shadows road, Keep in mind that in Florida bikes are allowed on sidewalks! This is where we recommend you ride, just be sure to ring your bell when passing other pedestrians. Along Oak Shadows road you will see some homes, eventually on the right the homes give way to nature. Make the first left turn you can, this will take you into Aquilla Reserve. To enter this neighborhood you will need to ride through a brick paved street, once inside you can get back onto the sidewalk.
- **3.** To your left you will see the four largest estate homes in Celebration. Take a left turn and and go around Aquilla Loop. Eventually you will see a wooden bridge that will take you across the lake, go around the lake and take a left onto the boardwalk through the woods. Go straight on this trail till the end then take a left again along Oak Shadows road. Continue along till to the intersection at Celebration AVE.
- **4.** On the left you will find a crosswalk, cross Celebration ave. and follow the sidewalk, you will find another wooden boardwalk. This is our longest stretch of path, eventually along this boardwalk you will find your way to a lake turn Right and continue along the wooden boardwalks.
- **5.** At the end of this section of trail you will find your self along Celebration BLVD, take a right and ride along the wide sidewalk, turn right on Ponce DR. Continue past the pool and clubhouse and the end of Ponce drive and take a left onto the lake front path out behind the pool.
- **6.** Continue alone this section of path until the fork in the trail and take a right. This takes you to Spring Park loop, take a left and continue straight along that road, this road will eventually change names to Maiden Street and then Maiden Terraces, however no turns are required.
- 7. Towards the end of that road you will find another wooden boardwalk, take that wooden boardwalk till it takes you to a lake stay to the left and find the next boardwalk. Once you get to fork on the trail take a right. Continue straight along Towhee court, cross the road at the crosswalk and go over the wooden bridge, Now things should start to look familiar as this is the trail you started on. Take a left at the end of the bridge and continue along the path till you make your way back to the bike stand.
