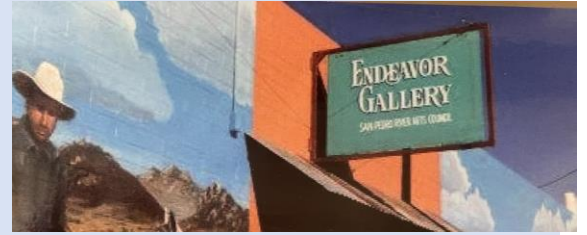


San Pedro River Arts Council Newsletter

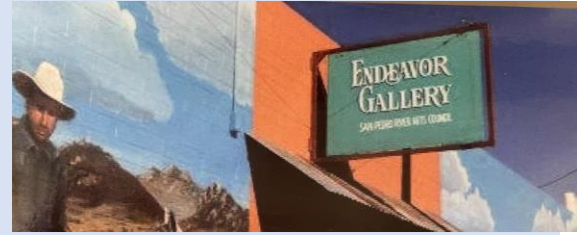

There will be a raffle. You can purchase tickets at the Endeavor Art Gallery.



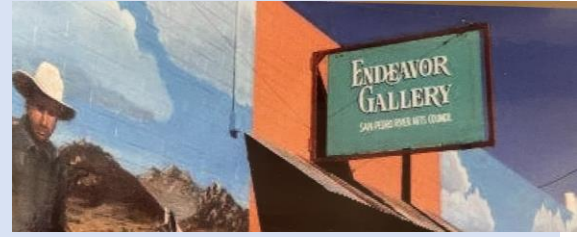
