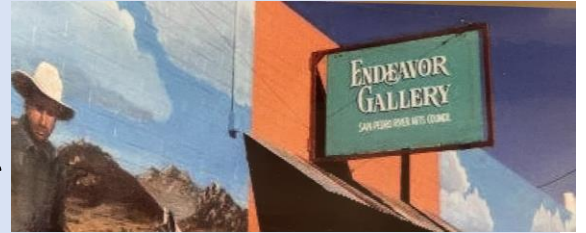

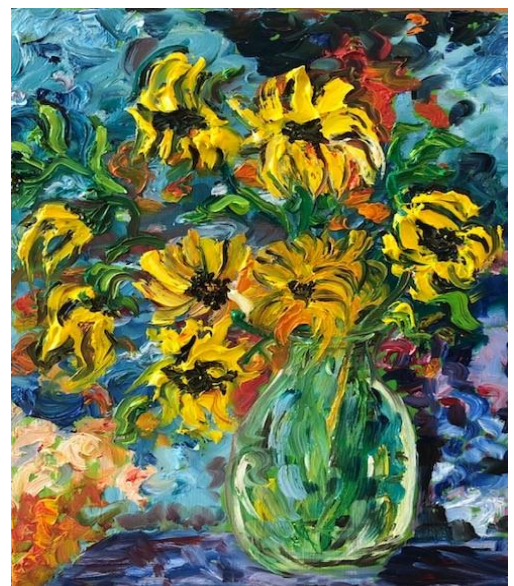
You may have seen her on the cover of the High Dessert Palette or have seen her beautiful creations in the gallery.

Marilynn creates fantastic wool paintings and is the author of the Henry children's book series.

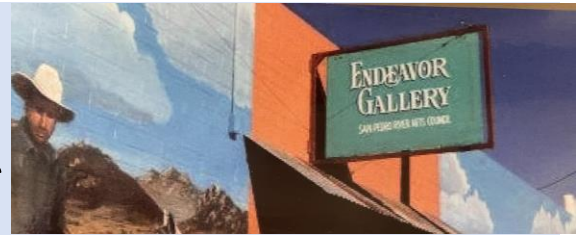
