## Policies and Procedures for Art Students

2018-2019

It is a great honor and joy for me to teach each one of your children. My goal is to provide my art students with the best instruction I can, to enrich their studies with additional fieldtrips and educational opportunities and to leave them with knowledge, understanding and a love for art and music that they will benefit from for the rest of their lives. Classes are scheduled in 4 quarters throughout the school year. Each quarter is 8-10 weeks long. I bill the first week of each session. The cost for classes is as follows:

Private Classes (one family):

In my studio:

\$25.00 per child plus material fee

\$8.00 for each additional child

At your home:

\$35.00 per child plus material fee

\$8.00 for each additional child

Material fees average \$8.00 per child per semester

Group Classes (multiple families):

\$15.00 per child for a 1 hour class

\$18.00 per child for a 1 hour 15 minute class

\$20 per child for a 1 hour and 30 minute class

I am thankful to have a full class lead this year. In order for me to be on time to each of my classes I have to make sure I begin and end when scheduled. Please give me 24 hours notice if you will be unable to attend a class. If students miss a class I gladly provide one make-up class per semester if given 24 hours notice.

In addition to our art classes children have the opportunity each winter and spring to participate in special art events.
