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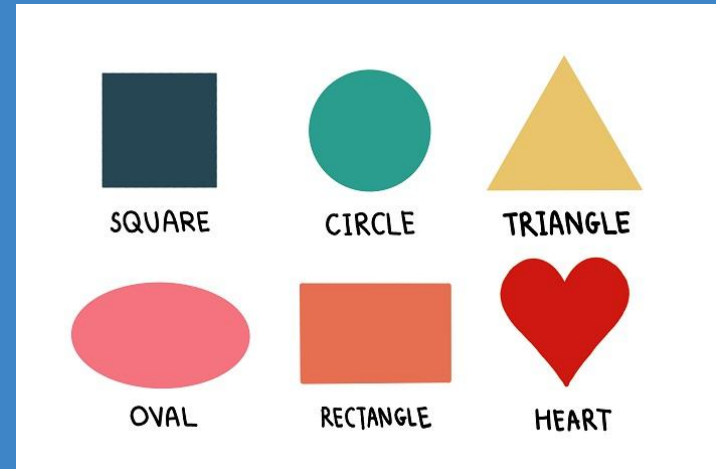
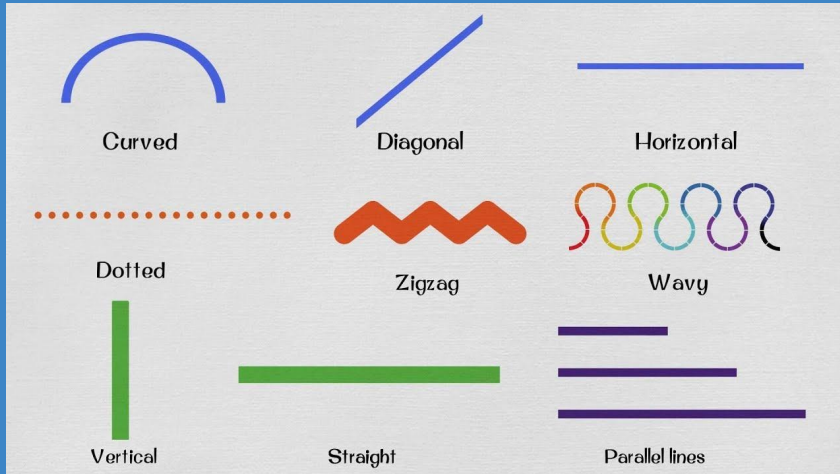

Important *words* you need to *know* !

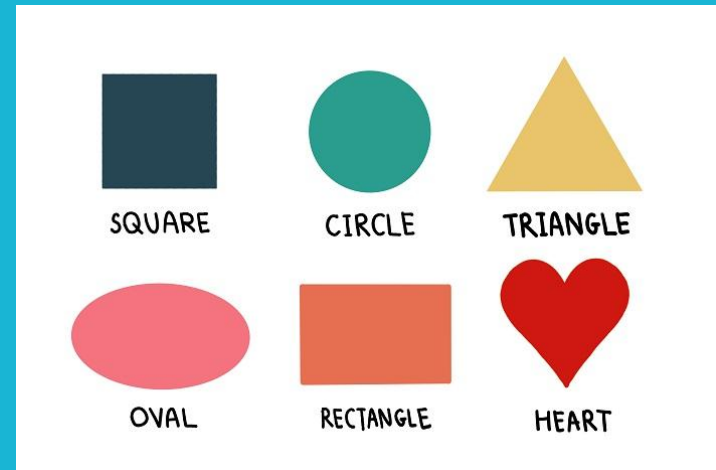
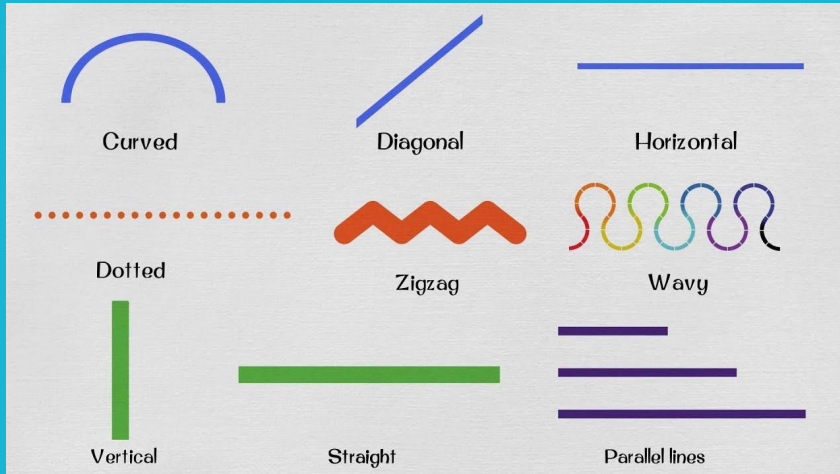


- Line: A dot that went for a walk.
 - Lines can move in LOTS of different directions
- Shape: A line that connects makes a shape



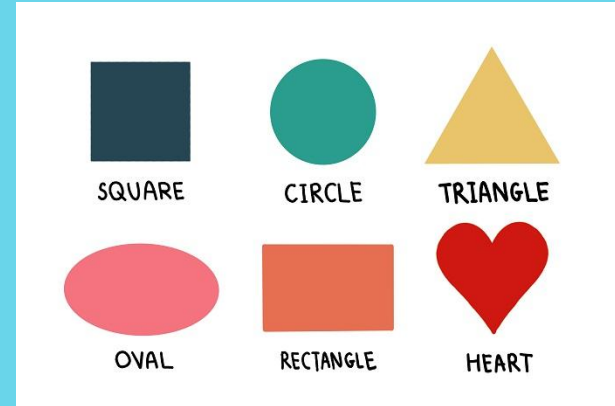
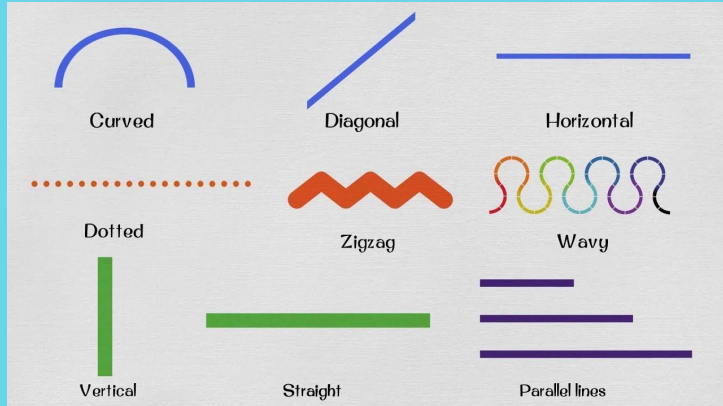
Let's Get *Started*. I Will Show You How...

- To connect lines to make 4 different types of shapes,



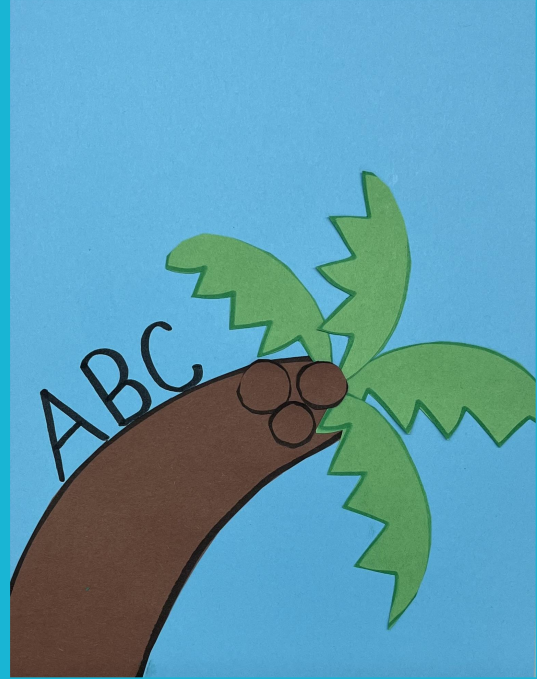
Now It's *Your* Turn!

- Can you make 3 different shapes?



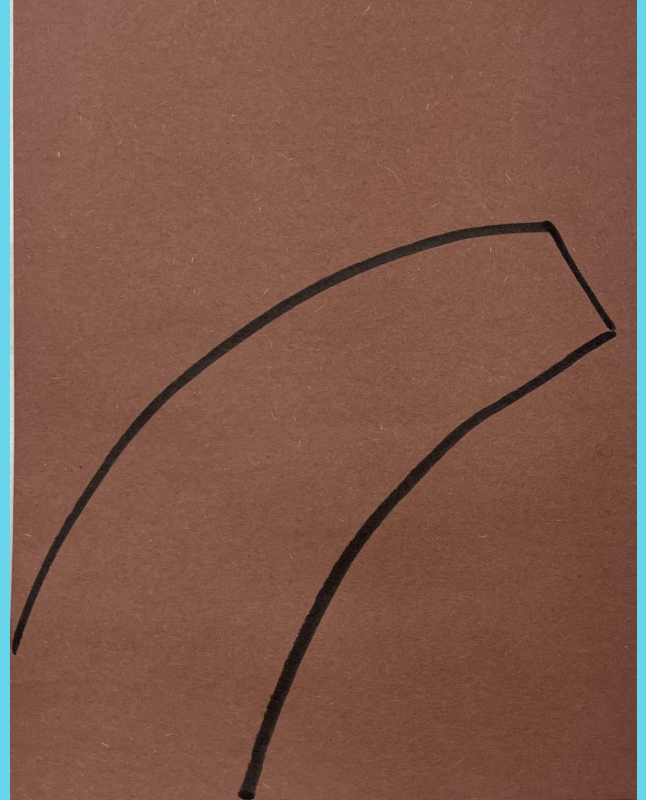
Up *Next*. I Will Show You How...

- To use lines and shapes to make a coconut tree like we saw in Chicka Chicka Boom Boom



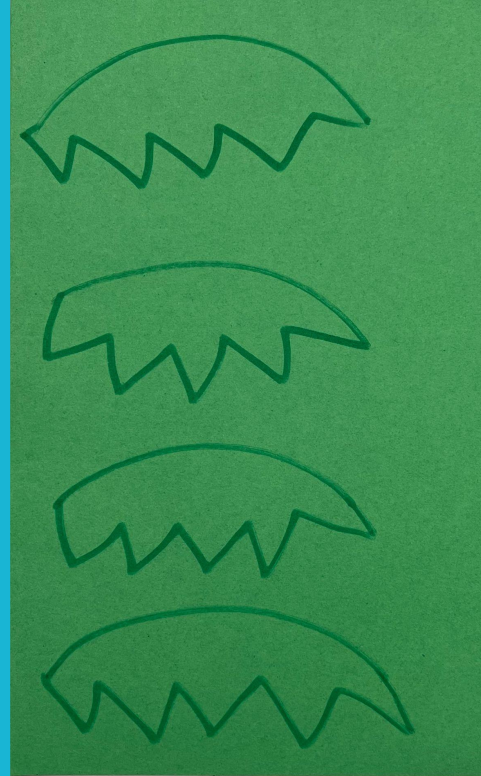
Up *Next*. I Will Show You How...

- Can you use a crayon and follow me and take a dot for a walk to make the trunk of a coconut tree on a piece of brown paper?



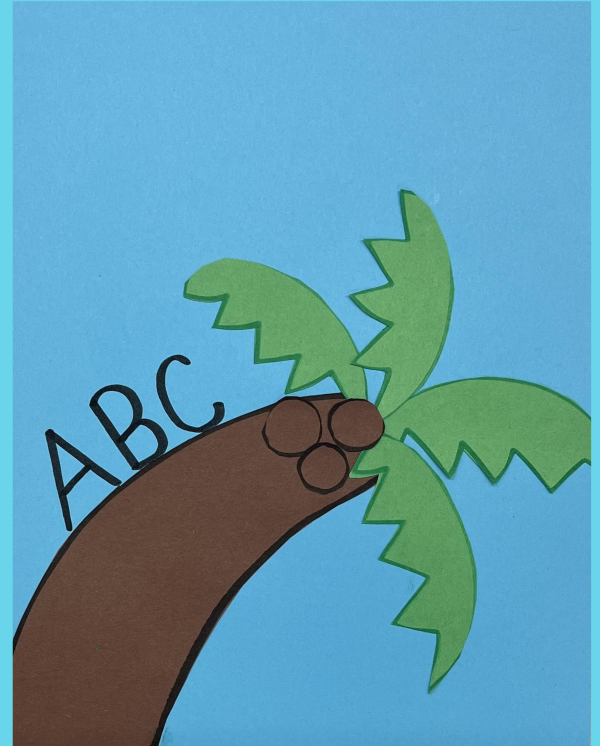
Up *Next*. I Will Show You How...

- Can you make a dot and take your dot for a walk to make a curved line and a zigzag line on a piece of green paper? These are your giant leaves!

- Now can you...
 - Cut your tree trunk and your leaves?
 - Glue the trunk onto your background paper.
 - Glue the leaves onto your trunk.
 - Last step....can you add your name or “ABC” to the trunk using a marker?
