MYTH

Dog poop is good fertilizer.

FACT

Dog waste is acidic and can damage grass and plants.



MYTH

It breaks down naturally.

FACT

Dog waste can take months to decompose and harbors harmful bacteria.



MYTH

It's just on my property—not hurting anyone.

FACT

Waste can wash into storm drains and contaminate local water supplies.

Why it matters:

- Spreads diseases to humans and pets (e.g. Giardia, E. coli, roundworms).
- Pollutes waterways, harming wildlife and ecosystems.
- It smells bad, ruins shoes, and damages community pride.



DO YOUR PART

SIMPLE TIPS FOR RESPONSIBLE PET OWNERSHIP

- Always carry waste bags when you walk your dog.
- Use pet waste stations or city trash cans.
- Dispose of bags in proper bins—not down storm drains.
- Encourage neighbors to clean up, too.
- Use biodegradable bags to reduce plastic waste.

MAKE IT A HABIT, NOT A HASSLE

 Keep a leash-side dispenser or tie a few bags to your dog's leash. Set reminders until it becomes second nature.

CITY LAW REMINDER

NYC Health Code §161.03 requires all pet owners to clean up after their dogs in public. Fines can reach \$250.



HEALTHY PETS, HEALTHY COMMUNITIES PREVENTING DISEASE AND BUILDING RESPECT

- Schedule regular vet visits to prevent the spread of parasites.
- Feed pets nutritious food to promote firm, easy-to-pick-up waste.
