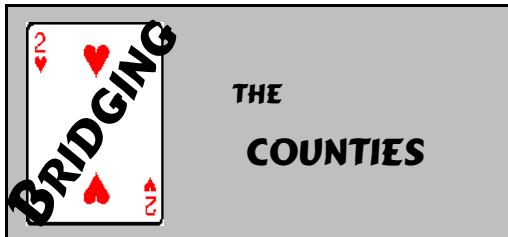

## Editor's Corner



There are just some things that I will never understand about this game.

Over the last few issues, I've commented in this column on inexplicable winning and losing streaks. The corollary is that, on any given day, you never can predict with certainty who will win an event.

Sure, you can bet the favorites. Consider the Nickell team in the Spingold, or try Larry Cohen and David Berkowitz in a pair game. But even the greats don't come close to winning every event they enter.

I got a shock when I opened my September *Bridge Bulletin*. Someone who I had played with, and planned on playing with again, won a national championship. Not a limited event, but a true open game against the big names. And not playing with a pro, either. Never would I have predicted this in a million years. I'm still shaking my head in disbelief.

My personal streak still seems to be on the winning side. When I didn't win my direction in a recent club game (I came in fourth), one pair questioned, "What

happened? Aren't you supposed to win every week?" They were just kidding, of course.

If you were to predict results beforehand based simply on the number of masterpoints held, I don't think I've entered an event I'd be expected to win since before I was a Life Master. And Paul Soloway would be favored every single time. We all know that I win events (and lose events) and Paul Soloway loses events (and wins events).

When was the last time you played in a game where even just stratification correctly predicted the order of finishing? I mean where every "A" pair beat every "B" pair, and every "B" pair beat every "C" pair. I have seen it happen. But not often. And not in many years.

This just proves two things. Masterpoints are not a good indicator of whether a player wins or not. And Bridge is like every other sport - where any team might win on any given day.

At least that I can understand.

## In Memoriam

### MORRIS FEIFER

Morris Feifer, Club Director of the Larchmont Temple's Wednesday night game, died on October 19, 2006 at the age of 82. Born in 1924, he was a clerk in the United States Postal Service for over 30 years. Morris and his wife Sonia were both Life Masters of the ACBL.

After joining Kay Samotus as co-director of the Larchmont Temple game, he took over as director in 1990. Each Wednesday night game ended with Morris's well known sign-off: "Thank you for coming. I hope I'll see you next week—and bring a friend."

Despite failing health over the last few years, he missed only those games when he was in the hospital. For over a year, Wednesday night player Richard Slavin, who lived some distance from Morris, drove him to and from each game.

## Golden Apple XXIV Swiss Teams

Concluding the WCBA's annual Closed Westchester Tournament on Sunday, January 7, will be the Golden Apple XXIV, a Swiss Teams event in two masterpoint flights.

The Golden Apple is a five-match contest that will take place at the Bridge Deck, starting at 12 noon. A complimentary bagel brunch will precede the game at 11:30 AM.

The two flights are open (no masterpoint restrictions) and 0-300. The event is limited to WCBA members and players who work in Westchester County but live elsewhere.

Co-sponsoring the Golden Apple for the 24th year is the Westchester County Department of Parks, Recreation and Conservation. Westchester medallions will be presented to the winning players in both flights.

## Changes to the Closed Westchester Tournament

This year the Friday afternoon game will be held at both the Bridge Deck and Hartes' Club. The starting time at both clubs is 1:00 PM. Scoring will be done across both clubs. Also, both clubs will provide complimentary food prior to the game.

All pairs games on Friday and Saturday are stratified. A: 2000+; B: 750-2000; C: 0-750.

As usual, there will be a complimentary cold buffet dinner between sessions at the Bridge Deck.

On Saturday, there will be two separate sessions at 1:00 PM and 7:00 PM at Riverview. The winners of the afternoon game will receive the Harriet Aks Memorial Trophy. In between sessions, there will be a cocktail hour and dinner. At the annual meeting, new Life Masters will be recognized.

The tournament concludes with the Golden Apple Swiss (see left column for details).

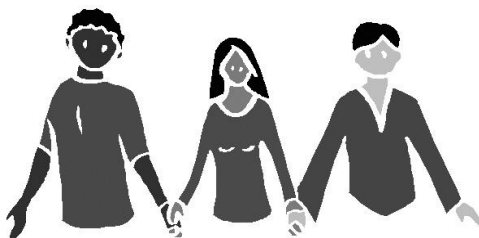
