

## Illness

## Policy

<input type="checkbox"/> Mouth sores	Child may return with doctor's clearance note stating that the sores are not contagious.
<input type="checkbox"/> Ringworm	Child cannot return until 72 hours after start of treatment, must also be cleared with a doctor's note and area must be fully covered while at school.
<input type="checkbox"/> Head lice	Child may not return until completely lice and nit free. Administration will inspect child's hair upon return for clearance.
<input type="checkbox"/> Hand, Foot, and Mouth	Child will be sent home if spots are noticed during the course of the school day. A doctor's note is required and child may not return until all spots are completely dried out.
<input type="checkbox"/> Impetigo	Child must stay home for 24 hours after medication administration.
<input type="checkbox"/> Strep throat	Must stay home until 24 hours after first round of antibiotic has been given and after the child has been fever free for 24 hours without fever reducing medication.
<input type="checkbox"/> Pertussis (whooping cough)	Child must remain home for 5 days after appropriate antibiotic treatment has begun and they are cleared with a doctor's note.
<input type="checkbox"/> Roseola	Child must remain home until 24 hours fever free WITHOUT medication.
<input type="checkbox"/> Sudden rash	Child must be seen and cleared with a doctor's visit and note stating that it is not contagious.
<input type="checkbox"/> Scabies	Child must stay home until treatment is completed.
<input type="checkbox"/> Flu/ Pneumonia	Child must remain home until symptom free for 24 hours WITHOUT medication.
<input type="checkbox"/> Stomach flu (Stomach bug)	Child must remain home until symptom free for 24 hours WITHOUT medication.
<input type="checkbox"/> RSV	Child may return after 24 hours symptom free WITHOUT medication and <b>no less than 3 days after a positive test</b> . Symptoms include coughing, wheezing, fever, runny nose, decreased appetite.
<input type="checkbox"/> Covid	Child must remain home until 24 hours fever free WITHOUT medication.

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<input type="checkbox"/> <b>Chronic, deep cough</b>	Child will be sent home if they present a deep and chronic cough, making them feel uncomfortable and unable to participate in the daily activities. They must remain home until they are able to comfortably participate in school. If the cough lasts more than 2 days, child must be cleared by a doctor's visit & note.
<input type="checkbox"/> <b>Fever (100.4F+)</b>	If Child has a fever of 100.4F or more they must remain home until 24 hours fever free WITHOUT medication.
<input type="checkbox"/> <b>Diarrhea</b>	2 or more episodes of diarrhea in the course of the school day. Child must remain home the following day and cannot return until 24 hours symptom free WITHOUT medication.
<input type="checkbox"/> <b>Vomiting</b>	1 or more episodes of vomiting during the school day. Child must remain home the day after and cannot return until 24 hours symptom free WITHOUT medication.
<input type="checkbox"/> <b>Conjunctivitis/ Pink eye</b>	Child may return after the third dose of medication
<input type="checkbox"/> <b>Persistent abdominal pain</b>	Abdominal pain that is persistent and continues for more than 1 hour. Child may return the following day if symptoms have subsided.
<input type="checkbox"/> <b>Ear infection</b>	Child may return with a clearance note if they do not have a fever and can participate comfortably.
