



RANKED CHOICE VOTING INSTRUCTIONS



The lowest vote getter is eliminated at the end of each round of voting, and that candidate's votes are then redistributed to other candidates according to each ballot's next highest ranked choice. This continues until one candidate achieves a majority of the votes.

1. **Circle** the number 1 next to your first choice candidate, the number 2 next to your second choice, the number 3 next to your third choice, and so forth.

2. **Do not use the same column twice for any office.** All choices must be different.

3. If you make a mistake, find a teller and ask for a new ballot, or else your ballot may be voided and/or your vote not counted.
