CLASSS 5, 6, 7, 8 WALK TROT EQUITATION, NOT TO EXCEED GROUND POLES - OPEN TO JUNIOR & AMATEUR RIDERS 11 YEARS OF AGE & OVER. RIDERS MAY NOT HAVE COMPETED MORE THAN 1 TIME IN A CLASS REQUIRING THEM TO CANTER. CLASSES 9, 10, 11 12 PEL

BEGINNER RIDER EQUITATION. 11 YRS AND UNDER NOT TO EXCEED 18"- OPEN TO JUNIOR RIDERS 11 YEARS OF AGE & UNDER WHO HAVE NOT SHOWN BEYOND CROSS RAILS. TROTTING NOT PENALIZED. CANTERING IN ONE AT A TIME. FENCES: CROSS RAILS WITHOUT FILLERS, UNDER 18".

BEGINNER RIDER EQUITATION. 12 AND OVER NOT TO EXCEED 18"- OPEN TO JUN-IOR & AMATEUR RIDERS 12 YEARS OF AGE & OVER WHO HAVE NOT SHOWN BE-YOND CROSS RAILS. TROTTING NOT PENALIZED. CANTERING IN ONE AT A TIME. FENCES: CROSS RAILS WITHOUT FILLERS, UNDER 18".

CLASSES 17 18 19 LEAD LINE EQUITATION, PEL NOT TO EXCEED GROUND **POLES -** OPEN JUNIOR

RIDERS 9 YEARS OF AGE AND UNDER. RIDERS MAY NOT HAVE COMPETED OFF THE LEAD OR IN ANY OTHER CLASS/DIVISION AT ANY SHOW. LEADER AND SIDE WALK-ERS MUST BE OVER THE AGE OF 14 AND APPROPRIATELY DRESSED.

CLASS 20 SCHOLARSHIP CLASS- JUDGED IN HAND WITH HALTER AND LEAD. HORSES WITH BE JUDGED BASED ON THE BEST GROOMED. CLASSES 21 22 23 24

SHORT STIRRUP EQUITATION PEL NOT TO EXCEED 18"- OPEN TO JUNIOR RIDERS 12 YEARS OF AGE AND UNDER AS OF DEC. 1ST OF THE CURRENT SHOW YEAR. TROTTING NOT PENALIZED.

CLASSES 25 26 27 28

LONG STIRRUP EQUITATION, 18"- OPEN TO JUNIOR AND AMATEUR RIDERS 13 YEARS OF AGE AND OVER. TROTTING NOT PENALIZED.

CROSS RAIL HUNTER, PEL 29, 30, 31, 32, OPEN TO ALL RIDERS AND ALL HORS-ES NOT TO EXCEED 18" CROSSRAILS. TROTTING NOT PENAILIZED

CROSSRAIL JUMPERS, PEL18" 33, 34, 35 OPEN TO ALL RIDGES AND ALL HORS-ES NOT TO EXCEED 18" CROSSRAILS, TROTTING NOT PENALIZED.

INTRO JUMPERS, PEL18" 36 37 38 OPEN TO ALL RIDGES AND ALL HORSES NOT TO EXCEED 18" STRAIGHT RAIL, TROTTING NOT PENALIZED.

SHORT LONG STIRRUP HUNTER DERBY DERBY HAS A TWO-ROUND FORMAT. THE FIRST ROUND IS A CLASSIC ROUND, RUN WITH THE THIRD HUNTER OVER FENCE CLASS WHERE A HORSE IS JUDGED ON PERFORMANCE, PACE, JUMPING STYLE, QUALITY AND MOVEMENT. THE SECOND ROUND IS A HANDY HUNTER ROUND, WHICH ENCOURAGES BRILLIANCE OF PACE (A MORE FORWARD, GAL-LOPING STRIDE) AND HANDINESS, WHICH MEANS RIDERS OPT FOR TIGHTER TURNS AND DIFFERENT TRACKS TO FENCES THAN THOSE TRADITIONALLY TAK-EN IN A HUNTER ROUND. JUDGES USE A NUMERICAL SCORING SYSTEM TO RATE THE HORSES AFTER EACH ROUND OF COMPETITION. THREE OPTIONAL FENC-ES WILL BE OFFERED FOR MORE POINTS

PRE SCHOOLING HUNTER 18" OPEN TO ALL RIDERS AND HORSES NOT TO EXCEED 18" STRAIGHT RAIL

Open to horses & ponies ridden by riders of ANY age. Fences LESS THAN 2' in height. Section A: Rider may not have shown in a division, at any show, where the fence height specifications are 2' or higher. Riders in section A may not cross enter in any division or class at any competition where fences are 2' or higher. The rider will be no longer eligible for Beginner's. Section B: Horse or pony not to have shown in a division, at any competition, where fence height specifications are 2' or higher. Horses may not cross enter into any division or class where fences are 2' or higher at the same competition.

MODIFIED EQUITATION 18", 36-39 OPEN TO AMATUER RIDERS, NOT TO EXCEED 18" STRAIGHT RAIL OPEN TO EXHIBITORS OF ANY AGE WHO HAVE NOT SHOWN IN A DIVISION, AT ANY SHOW, WHERE THE FENCE HEIGHT SPECIFICATIONS ARE 2' OR HIGHER. TO BE SHOWN OVER A COURSE LESS THAN 2'. RIDERS MAY NOT CROSS ENTER INTO ANY OTHER DIVISION OR CLASS WHERE FENCES ARE 2' OR HIGH-ER.TROTTING ON COURSE NOT TO BE PENALIZED, ALTHOUGH AN UN-INTENTIONAL BREAK OF GAIT WILL BE PENALIZED.

HVHS OUTREACH HUNTER DERBY 2' 2'6" 3'

DERBY HAS A TWO-ROUND FORMAT. THE FIRST ROUND IS A CLASSIC ROUND, RUN WITH THE THIRD HUNTER OVER FENCE CLASS WHERE A HORSE IS JUDGED ON PERFORMANCE, PACE, JUMPING STYLE, QUALITY AND MOVEMENT. THE SECOND ROUND IS A HANDY HUNTER ROUND, WHICH ENCOURAGES BRIL-LIANCE OF PACE (A MORE FORWARD, GALLOPING STRIDE) AND HANDINESS, WHICH MEANS RIDERS OPT FOR TIGHTER TURNS AND DIFFERENT TRACKS TO FENCES THAN THOSE TRADITIONALLY TAKEN IN A HUNTER ROUND. JUDGES USE A NUMERICAL SCORING SYSTEM TO RATE THE HORSES AFTER EACH ROUND OF COMPETITION. THREE OPTIONAL FENCES WILL BE OFFERED FOR MORE POINTS
