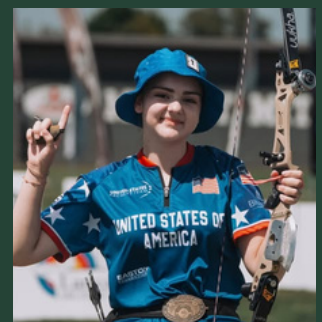
NFAA August Event Recap
