JOAD Archery Class - Spring 2019

Class Overview

This is a beginner archery class which will concentrate on archery safety and basic shooting form. All participants must be at least 8 years of age. Each child will progress at their own pace and ability. This will be a non-competitive environment, but those who desire may measure their progress by scoring in order to attain achievement awards. No equipment is required but you can shoot with your own equipment if desired.

Archery Tournaments

While it is not required to compete in any tournaments, there are members of the JOAD class, often referred to as “The Team” that compete regularly. There is no qualification score required to be eligible. However, it is suggested you do not shoot in a competitive setting until you can consistently hit the target. Keep in mind, at any USA Archery event archers must shoot at a minimum of 18M (approx 20yds) Additional registration fee required for tournaments. You must have your own equipment.

Algonquin JOAD Instructors may or may not be available at events for assistance.
