The Algonquin JOAD and Adult Achievement

The Algonquin Archers is proud to be part of USA Archery's JOAD and Adult Achievement program. Our JOAD program is open to anyone a minimum of 8 years old. Members are eligible for the program through the year of their 20th birthday. Equipment is available at the club to be used for class. A USA Archery membership is required. JOAD TEAM

Some of our members are interested in competing in the sport of archery. As a member of USA Archery you are eligible to enter anything from state championships to national events. While USA Archery host state indoor and outdoor tournaments, our coaches and instructors will also introduce you to formats, games, and tournaments hosted by NFAA as well as field archery and 3D shoots. There is no requirement to compete. Many members join the program just for the fun of it. Please note, additional fee required for tournament registration. This is paid to the host organization. Keep in mind, for USA Archery events, archers will need to be able to shoot 18M (aprox 20yds) for indoor events. Outdoor will range from 30M-70M depending on age. For

tournaments, archers will need to have their own equipment.



Class will be held either outdoors on the practice range or indoor range. For those with more experience and their own equipment the temporary tournament-distance field (50M, 60M, 70M) as well as the field or 3D courses can be used.

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Cost: For members of Algonquin archers, the sessions will be \$100 for a 10 week sessions. Non-club members are \$185. As stated above, equipment is available at the club for classes. Archers looking to compete should have their own equipment.
