Members are eligible for the program through the year of their 20th birthday. Equipment is available at the club to be used for class. A USA Archery membership is required. ## JOAD TEAM

Some of our members are interested in competing in the sport of archery. As a member of USA Archery you are eligible to enter anything from state championships to national events. While USA Archery host state indoor and outdoor tournaments, our coaches and instructors will also introduce you to formats, games, and tournaments hosted by NFAA as well as field archery and 3D shoots. There is no requirement to compete. Many members join the program just for the fun of it. Please note, additional fee required for tournament registration. This is paid to the host organization. Keep in mind, for USA Archery events, archers will need to be able to shoot 18M (approx 20yds) for indoor events. Outdoor will range from 30M-70M depending on age. For

tournaments, archers will need to have their own equipment.



### The return to (new) normal - post COVID

Classes are held outdoors, weather permitting, with up to 10 students on the shooting line. Classes will be moved indoors with inclement weather. Mask are not required for the class, but you are welcome to use them to fit your comfort level.

## Details



For members of Algonquin archers, the sessions will be \$75 for a 10 week sessions. Non-club members are \$150. As stated above, equipment is available at the club for classes.
