Her areas of focus have included education policy and planning, applied research programme design and development, and policy and programming to reducing gender inequalities. She pursued graduate studies at Kenyatta University, earned her PhD at Stanford University and has lived in the USA, Kenya, Tanzania, Namibia, Malawi, and France.
