Project: Orphan Care- Education & Training

- Education is the key to helping or providing opportunities for a community or society to break free from the cycle of poverty, and is a major catalyst towards improvements in many aspects of the lives of the poor. Poverty leads to illiteracy, and in turn illiteracy leads to further poverty – a vicious circle that needs to be eliminated with our donors' help.
- We are providing basic schools in the more inaccessible and marginalized regions, to educate orphans and other needy people, and to develop educational packages and vocational courses that are specifically aimed to cater for their needs.
- Even where some facilities for education are available, they are normally under resourced with open-air schools, poor buildings, few books and teachers with little or no training. Where possible, we hope to work with schools like these with a view to improving the quality of education available to the needy. This involves the distribution of school equipment, books and computers; as well as paying for the teachers to be trained to a more competent and professional level.

Project: Orphans Village

Delhi is one of the world's great cities: on the surface bustling, vibrant, teeming with life. But the quality of life is very different, especially for the twenty percent of inhabitants who live in the slums. And within the slums are countless orphans, surviving in hunger and poverty; sleeping rough with little prospect of an improving future.

Our partner, Orphans in Need has commissioned twenty-four houses, which will each accommodate **12 orphans and a widow**. The Orphans Village will feature an integrated school providing primary/secondary education and skills training in the second phase. Not all our Orphans develop at the same rate so our village houses a transition centre; a half-way home for those who require a little more support before they leave. A focus on social, living and personal skills will provide the confidence to attain a measure of independence

288 orphans who have lost their parents will be accommodated. Each child will be clothed, educated to the highest local standards and receive a minimum of three meals a day. All special needs will be accommodated, including disabilities. Medical treatment and counselling will be available, if required. Our fully trained staff and volunteers will care for these children in a family-oriented environment. Each home will have live-in mothers to provide that essential motherly love.

The Orphans Village will be a centre of excellence that will provide our children with a loving and peaceful environment, where children will aspire to bettering their lives through the provision of the highest quality education and support.

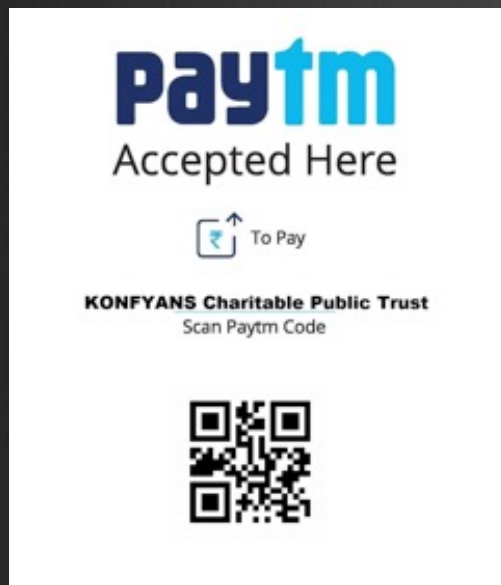
