Providing hope for a family in need

The majority of people living in poverty in the developing world are widows and their children. The reality is that men are often the main breadwinners. Widows and orphans are left to beg for help or have to go out to work leaving their children unattended.

The mothers of these children barely have enough food to feed their family. If they had this, it would give them the hope and ability to go to school, reclaim their childhood and break out of the cycle of poverty.

Justification of the Project

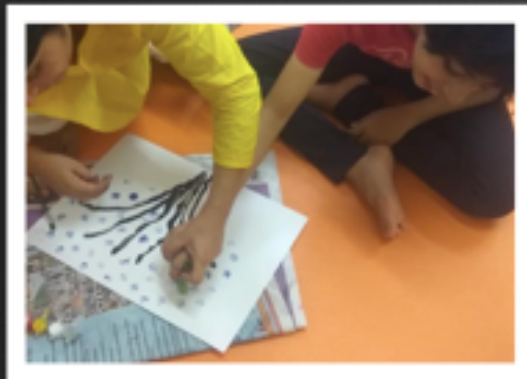
There is a lack of Daycare facilities for children with special needs so there either left unattended or with unskilled care takers. Even lack of school programs negatively impacts the development of a special child who constantly struggles to fit in daily routine which also takes a toll on the career and health of parents of special child. In order to build their self confidence there is a severe need for an inclusive , friendly and relaxing environment where a special child can make friends, learn through activities and become a part of the society.

Focus Areas: Assist Differently Abled Children

Early Intervention | Inclusive Education | Rehabilitation | Training | Counseling

Special children will be provided with early intervention which starts from the age of 3 till 5 years with major focus on cognitive development , motor planning and sensory integration. We will provide after school program to children of age 6 to 8 years with the help of team of pre-vocational trainer , speech and language therapist , occupational therapist, special education and sports. We endeavour to provide homely environment and endure ADL skills for independent living.

Different forms of exercise or any sports activity benefits such children as it can decrease harmful self-stimulating behavior and delivers the same health boosts as it does for neuro-typical kids: weight loss, heart health, stress relief. Any sports activity can help address problems associated with low muscle tone and child's core muscles.

Focus Areas: Training of student centric Sports | Transition | Increased Participation | Physical Fitness | Movement Therapy | Engagement with training in Special Olympics | Physical therapy and Brain Gym training at early age | Recognition and Development of Splinter Skills | Timely assessments of Psychiatric Disorders like ADHD, ADD, OCD, which may be as a co-morbid condition diagnosed later.

Kechla Outreach Programme: Environment

The hills have become barren and infertile due to soil erosion in the surrounding areas. The relevance of environment management cannot be underestimated, considering the living conditions in this area, which are backward and still very underdeveloped. We felt it is important that the villagers, youth and children realize the value of hygiene and ways to manage the environment.

The specific Goal for this project which will be completed by March'2020 are :

- Create awareness and knowledge of environment through various activities, site visits and workshops.
- Provide healthy organic fruits by encouraging a lot of tree plantation of fruits like cashew, tamarind, Mango etc. in the coming year
- To instill a sense of responsibility for the environment and appreciating our surroundings in youth and children by involving in these activities
- Enhancing their skills in managing environment, surroundings and various horticulture projects
- Composting sites that could be used to help gardens flourish and raise awareness among students so that they understand environmental issues and reduce waste all around
- Prevent soil erosion and make nearby land more fertile for plantation

Project Background: Making Higher Education Accessible

Goseeko has been making higher education study material accessible in states like Bihar, Odisha, Maharashtra, UP etc. focused on underprivileged students in Tier 2/3 Colleges through online methods and engaging professors to take live and recorded lectures to enable completion of their semester studies in line with the syllabus structure of the University. Students in Tier 2/3 colleges have extreme difficulties in studying because of lack of adequate study material. They have no libraries, they have cheap guide-books that are not adequate, photocopied material, borrowed notes that are dated, no professors or under qualified professors to guide them etc. Goseeko is making these the study materials and good quality professors available so that they can clear their semester exams and complete their education.

Goseeko makes it easier for Professors from the community to come together on the same environment to contribute towards making the content that is delivered on the platform for students to consume. The courses that are now made available are Engineering, BA, BCom, BAF, BMS etc. and new courses like BSc, Law etc. are being made ready to be launched soon for students in these streams.

These students are also then made to go through upskilling & certification courses and are introduced to companies for Internship programs and coached, so that they get a higher chance of getting placed for a better life. The upskilling and certification programs also include soft skill programs like English speaking modules, presentation skills, Interview skills, communication skills etc.

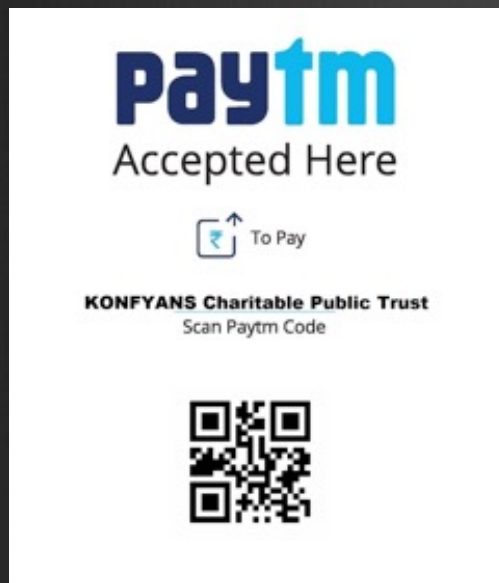
