Pets of the Month: Honey, Cypress and Maple

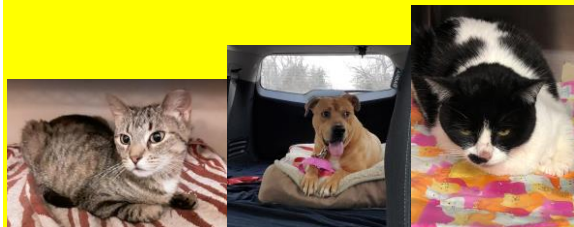
