Core Premise

MBTI types aren't just preferences or personality traits. They reflect patterned ways of processing meaning, attention, and interaction. Structure □, Function f, System ⊚, and Procedure ∼ serve as a sociological lens—revealing how each type operates within roles, behavior, and meaning-making.

Key Innovations

- Hybrid Constructs: Each type has a two-part cognitive role (e.g., Systematic Functionalist)
- Cognitive Interaction Code: A 16-code system (D/S patterns) to describe intertype dynamics
- Mental State Variants: Adds 6 functional overlays (e.g., depression, ADHD) for 96 total types
- A socio-implicative model connecting all 16 types through four interlocking roles—Discovery, Validation, Synthesis, and Direction.
